Esther is a 6-year-old girl with a big smile. She comes from Lira, 335 kilometers north of the capital city Kampala. In March 2021, Esther was diagnosed with Wilms Tumor and started receiving chemotherapy at the National Referral Hospital in Kampala. Esther's mother did not know anyone in Kampala and so they stayed at the hospital most of the time, with no money to buy necessities.

That is when the doctors referred them to the Bless a Child Foundation care homes that take care of children suffering from cancer. Esther and her mother came to stay at BCF in April 2022. At the BCF care home, they are provided with accommodation, nutritious meals, class, play therapy, and transport to and from the hospital at no cost.

At BCF, Esther enjoys reading, writing and storytelling.



Esther's dream is to become a doctor so she can treat other children suffering from cancer. We are grateful to our donors and partners for the support that has made a difference in Esther's life.

Grace Home Second Anniversary



On August 3, 2022, the Grace Home of Bless a Child Foundation celebrated 2 years since it opened its doors to children suffering from cancer. The Grace home is located in Mbarara city, 260 kilometers west of the capital city Kampala. It mainly accommodates children suffering from cancer receiving their treatment at Mbarara Regional Referral Hospital. of service in western Uganda to children receiving treatment at Mbarara Regional

Since it was opened in 2020, the Grace home has helped to reduce treatment abandonment at the hospital from 30% in 2020 to 10% in 2022. The home can accommodate up to 30 children together with their caregivers. We are grateful to all our friends who have supported us through this journey and still continue to stand with us.
